MYAA YOUTH COACHES CLINICS

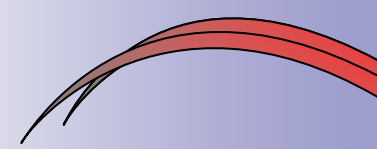
The MYAA is dedicated to teaching those who teach our kids.
